DISPUTES COMMITTEE: Convenor, Chief Steward & Show Secretary

RESPONSIBILITY ON EXHIBITORS TO NOTIFY THE SHOW SECRETARIES OF THEIR INTENTION TO COMPETE FOR ASSOCIATION TROPHIES. Exhibitors must send their points to each Show Secretary AND to the Association Secretary within 14 days of each Show. Each Show Secretary will verify the exhibitor's points with the Association Secretary.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: *Fully complete the Official Entry form- one horse per form (photocopied forms are accepted), to submit on show day with payment.*

ALL HORSES ENTERED MUST HAVE AN ENTRY FORM & PIC NUMBER

RULES:

- 1/ *Classes will be split at Judges discretion (if sufficient entries)*
- 2/ *Protest in writing and accompanied by \$50 must be lodged with the Secretary within one hour of the event being held.*
- 3/ *There will be NO REFUND of entry money of the closing date of entries (Sun 23 August)*
- 4/ *All horses & riders entered in graded showjumping events must be registered with the EFA and carry current performance cards*
- 5/ *All riders in Jumping events to wear approved EFA helmets Riders must be dressed in the correct attire whilst walking the course and receiving prize money and ribbons*
- 6/ *As condition of entry into the various events, competitors acknowledge that they ride at their own risk and that they are aware that activities involving horses can be hazardous & that the EFA and The PORT LINCOLN A&H Society committee and organisers will not accept liability or responsibility for any accident or injury to any person, animal or property, no matter however caused.*
- 7/ **HEADGEAR:** *Competing riders must wear headgear applicable to their level of competition. Approved safety helmets are to worn at all times with the retaining harness secured and fastened when training/practising at an event. Current accepted safety helmet standards are:*
 - *AS/NZS 3838 (Current Australian Standard) : EN1384 (Current European Standard)*
 - *:ASTN F1163 (Current US Standard)*
- 8/ *The committee and organisers reserve the right to make any alterations to the schedule as they deem necessary.*
